<p>What is the overall deductible?</p>	<p>Network providers: \$1,500/individual or \$3,000/family Out-of-network provider: Not Covered</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from providers up to the deductible amount before this plan begins to pay. The deductible is Embedded. If you have other family members on the plan, each family member must meet their own individual deductible until the total amount of deductible expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible. Deductible year runs 10/01 – 09/30</p>
<p>Are there services covered before you meet your deductible?</p>	<p>Yes. Preventive care services are covered before you meet your deductible.</p>	<p>This plan covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the deductible amount. But a copayment or coinsurance may apply. For example, this plan covers certain preventive care without cost-sharing and before you meet your deductible. The out-of-pocket limit is Embedded. If you have other family members in this plan, they have to meet their own out-of-pocket limits until the overall family out-of-pocket limit has been met.</p>
<p>What is not included in the out-of-pocket limit?</p>	<p>Premiums, balance billing charges, and health care this plan doesn't cover.</p>	<p>Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the out-of-pocket limit.</p>
<p>Will you pay less if you use a network provider?</p>	<p>Yes. See www.LTFBenefits.com or call 800-948-3253 for a list of network providers.</p>	<p>This plan uses a provider network. Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? **Yes**
